HOLE No. 10 PAR four YARDS 404

This beautiful, tree-lined par 4 requires an accurate tee shot to avoid being blocked by the huge trees that protect both sides of the fairway. Rattlesnake Creek runs along the left side of the fairway and then crosses both in front of and behind the green, adding to the challenge of the approach shot.



Rattlesnake Creek wraps around the front, right side and behind the slightly elevated 10th green.



Two huge oak trees guard both sides of the fairway.
