HOLE No. 2 PAR three YARDS 201

This classic par three stretches to 201 yards from the back tee. Bunkers left and right catch a lot of balls. There is an opening between the sand traps, but the green is slightly elevated, so balls hit on the front edge sometimes spin back down the slope. This is a large, two-tiered green, so it's important to get your ball on the correct level to have a makable putt.



This is a large green with two levels, front and back.



It's important to use enough club to carry the bunkers, although the downhill chip from behind the green can be tricky.
