This is perhaps the most difficult tee shot on the course, with Rattlesnake Creek grabbing almost every errant drive that goes left. It's more than 290 yards to the second creek crossing, so even the strongest player generally lays up short of that. After a good drive, it's still 280 yards to a green guarded by trees and a pot bunker in front and a lake on the right.



This huge green is visually deceptive because of the bunker in front.



Tee shots must stay on the right side to avoid ending up in the creek.
